

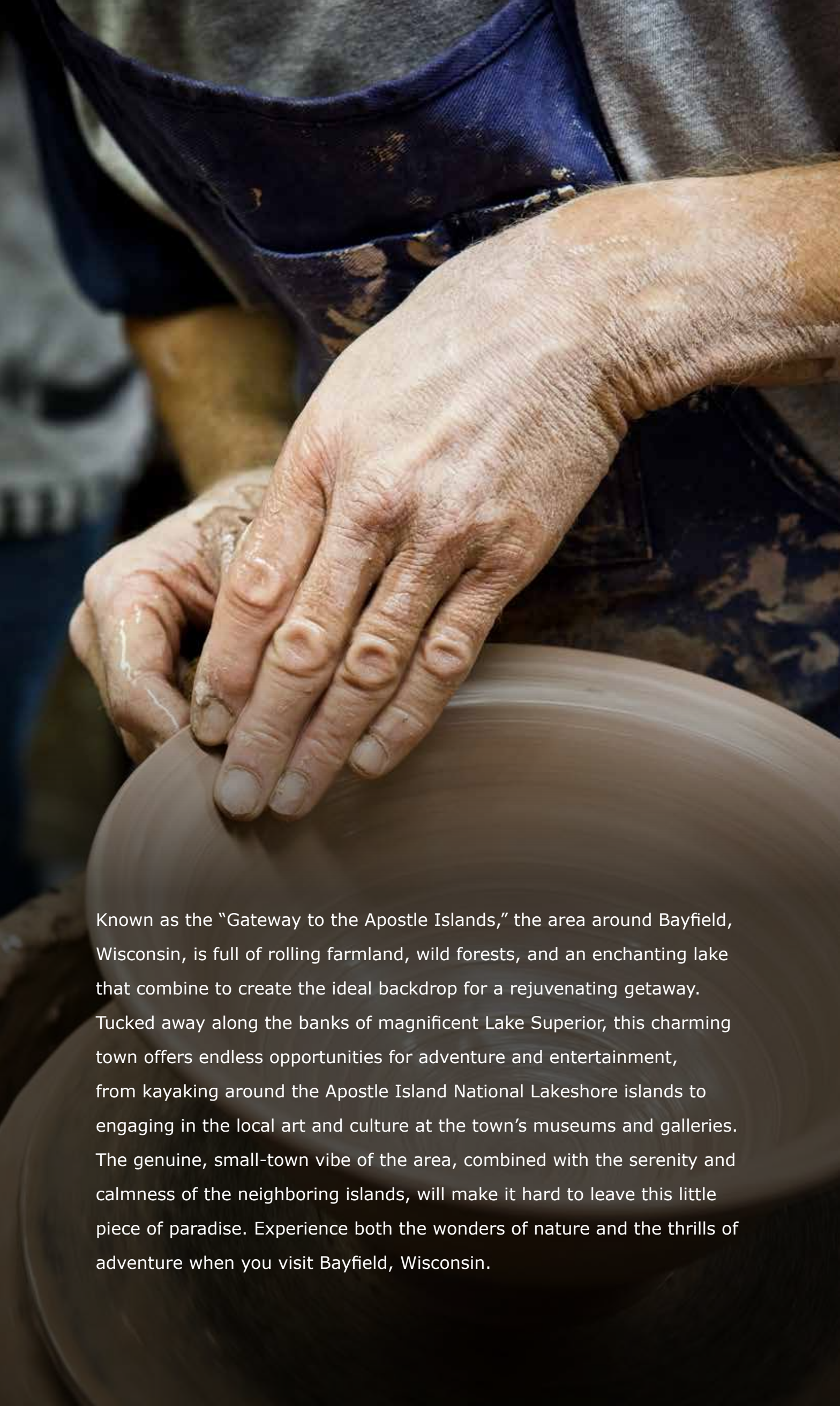

ELISHA'S ROOM

Holly's Room is located on the second floor of the Main House with an exposure to the north. WHISPERING PINES ROOM

This second-floor Garden House room is amazing with a queen bed, corner fireplace, beautiful “claw foot whirlpool,” and private bath with shower. The layout offers abundant daylight and starlight, thanks to eastern, southern and western exposures. This is the innkeeper’s choice with the wonderful whirlpool tub. Relax in the unique claw foot whirlpool – gazing into the corner fireplace. Slip into the Pinehurst robes, enveloped by softness and comfort.
